We spent our 12th winter in the Coachella Valley (Palm Springs, CA). where we had time for rest and relaxation and were able to catch up on paper work.

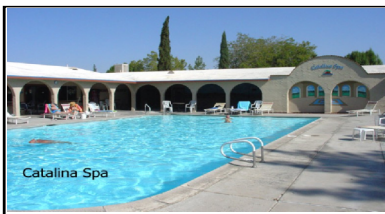
Kathy sang every Sunday morning at a church service, and then in the afternoon she joined other talented musicians, poets and singers at the Jam Session at Catalina Spa.

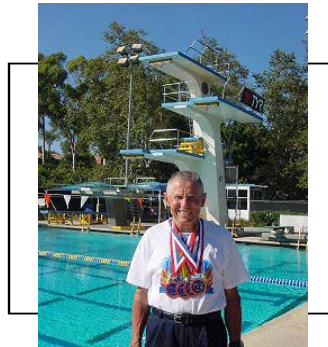
