On The Road

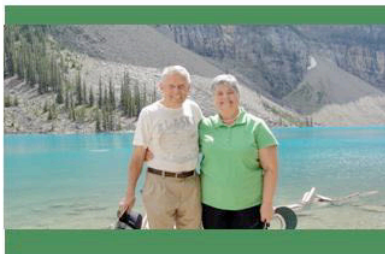

We missed our Spokane grandchildren as they recently moved to Houston Texas.

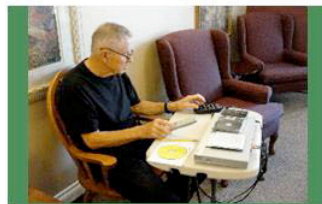


Gordon's Log
